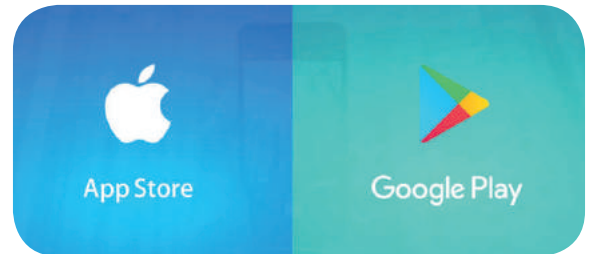

Dr. Michael Rydelnik is Professor of Jewish Studies and Bible at Moody Bible Institute. The son of Holocaust survivors, he was raised in a Jewish home in Brooklyn, New York. Michael accepted Jesus in high school and began teaching the Bible almost immediately. He graduated from Moody Bible Institute, Azusa Pacific University, Dallas Theological Seminary, and Trinity Evangelical Divinity School, where his doctoral research focused on the messianic hope of the Hebrew Bible. He is the author of several books and is the co-editor of and contributor to *The Moody Bible Commentary*. Michael and his wife, Eva, live in Chicago and have two adult sons.
