Charitable Giving Deductions

Following tax law changes, cash donations of up to \$300 made in the calendar year of 2020 are now deductible without having to itemize when people file their taxes in 2021.

This deduction lowers both adjusted gross income and taxable income – translating into tax savings for those making donations to qualifying tax-exempt organizations.

Cash donations include those made by check, credit card or debit card. They don't include securities, household items or other property. Though cash contributions to most charitable organizations qualify, some don't. People should review Publication 526, Charitable Contributions for details.

By law, recordkeeping rules apply to any taxpayer claiming a charitable contribution deduction. Usually, this includes getting a receipt or acknowledgement letter from the charity before filing a return and retaining a cancelled check or credit card receipt.
