We invite you to join a diverse assembly of Lima and Allen County pastors and spiritual leaders as they, along with invited business leaders, educators, musicians and city and county civic leaders lead the area in prayer.

The Lima chapter of the National Day of Prayer Task Force has called believers to prayer on this day for more than 25 years and continues with passion to mobilize community prayer for our city, county, state and nation.

Americans from all walks of life will gather on May 6th to lift up our country in prayer on the National Day of Prayer. Our nation has endured a year marked by unprecedented challenges, but we know prayer has carried us through these days and God will continue to lead us as we move forward.

This year marks 70 years since Reverend Billy Graham stood on the capitol steps in February 1952 and called for congress and the president to establish a day of prayer. By April of that year, President Truman signed the legislation into public law.

Through the decades, the National Day of Prayer Task Force has mobilized Americans to observe the National Day of Prayer in all 50 states and in U.S. territories to pray for those who lead and those in need in our nation.

As we believe and pray in 2021, our theme echoes our prayers: "LORD pour out Your LOVE, LIFE, and LIBERTY."

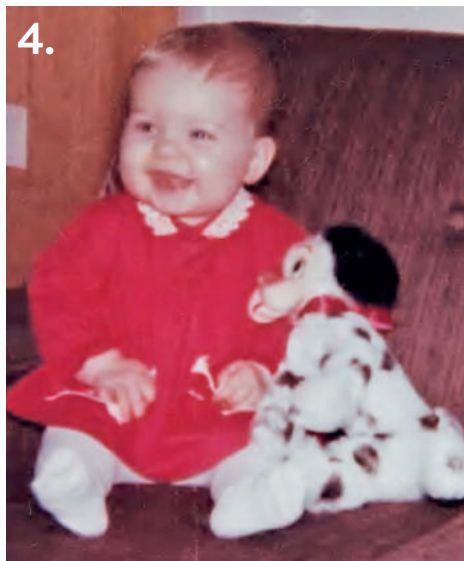
This year's theme verse is 2 Corinthians 3:17 which says:
