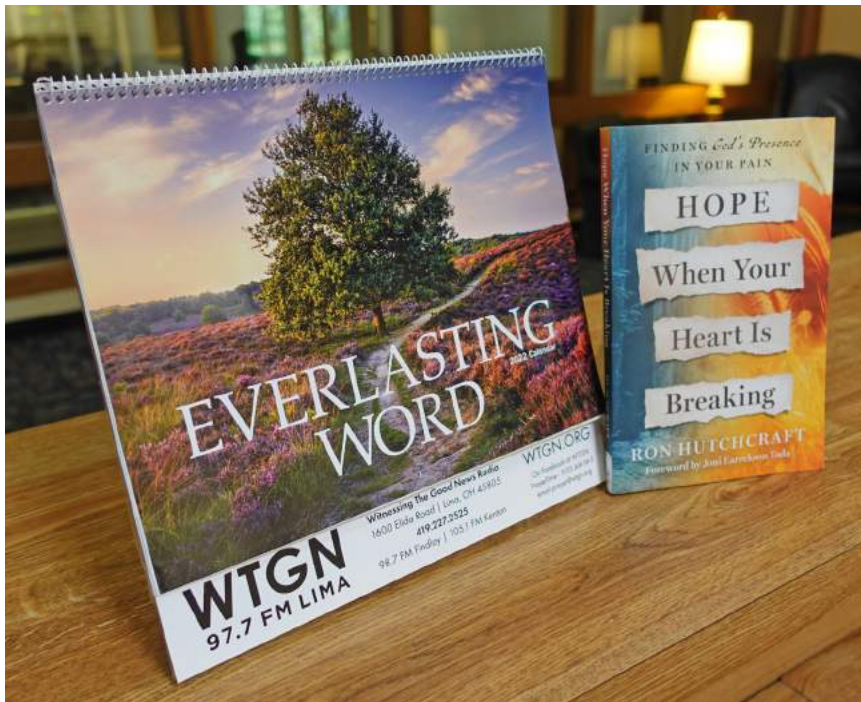

When WTGN signed on the air on September 27th, 1966, the original broadcast day was from 8am to 8pm. Gradually, more hours were added, and on August 20th, 1968 we began broadcasting 24 hours a day. WTGN was the first 24-hour-a-day broadcast station in Lima. Now, you can listen to WTGN anytime, anywhere on the mobile app or at WTGN.org.
