IGNITE is a 5 day mission opportunity for believers to demonstrate the Love of Christ through helping their neighbors with home improvement projects. IGNITE meets with homeowners, evaluates their needs, and then provides the Body of Christ with the materials and opportunities to meet those needs. Volunteers choose what projects they work on, and then spend the day with other volunteers completing the service projects, while sharing the Love of Christ with the homeowner.

- Clean host facilities
- Transport materials
