- Transport materials

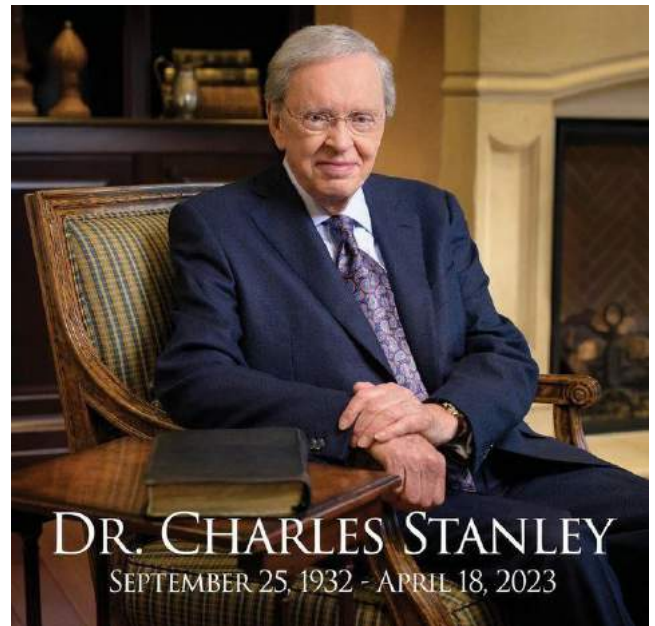
New Host Location

Celebrating The Life and Ministry of Dr. Charles Stanley

Dr. Charles Stanley, the longtime senior pastor at the First Baptist Church Atlanta and the founder of In Touch Ministries, passed away on Tuesday, April 18, 2023, at his home. He turned 90 earlier this year.

WTGN Station Manager Scott Young said, "In Touch has been a part of the WTGN broadcast schedule for over 40 years. Dr. Stanley has shared his heart and passion for the Word of God so faithfully. The one comment that I've heard from listeners through the years has been that 'I always had questions about my salvation and whether or not I could go to heaven some day. But, because of Dr. Stanley and his Bible teaching on In Touch, I now know without a doubt that I am saved, forgiven, loved by God, and on my way to heaven.'"
