You can drop off Christian books or Bibles to WTGN, 1600 Elida Road in Lima, during our office hours, Monday through Friday from 8am to 4pm.

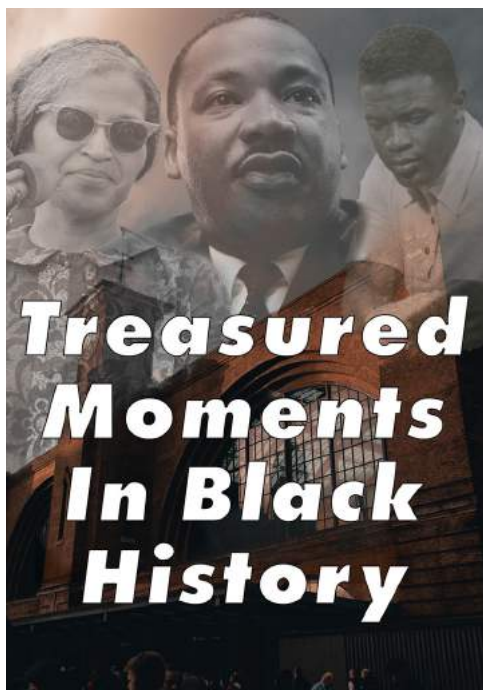
Mission Cry accepts all versions of Bibles in used condition, as long as they are legible. They do not accept hymnals, sheet music, CDs, or DVDs.
